

Feature focus: Take Register

Enhanced Take Register Screen

We are enhancing the **Take Register** screen to include a **Group View** (formerly known as Week View), making it easier to view and manage registers across groups.



Improved New Contact Workflow

We are improving the **New Contact** experience to help keep your data correct and easy to manage.

Soon, new **contacts** will need to be **linked to a student** before they can be finalised, preventing incomplete or orphaned records.

We are also enhancing the UI to make it clearer when you are **linking an existing contact versus creating a new one** - helping reduce duplicates and making the process faster and more intuitive.



Feature focus: Administration

Improved Single Central Record (SCR) Navigation

We are improving the **SCR** to make it clearer and easier to navigate.

- HR users will be able to **click a staff member's name** to open and edit their staff record.
- Click on **headline figures** (such as Incomplete Records or Issues) to instantly **filter** the SCR to the relevant staff, making record management faster and more efficient.




Feature focus: Clubs & Trips




Feature focus: Options

Student Choices

We are making it quicker and easier to review students' **final subject choices**.

Once choices are marked as final, you'll be able to generate a **report** showing each student's selected subjects.

We are enhancing **Cover** and **Non-Contact Code** processes to give you more control when reapplying the timetable.

A new **Protect Cover/NCC Entries** option will allow you to keep existing cover and non-contact codes in place, ensuring that both past and future entries are retained when timetable changes are applied.



Feature focus: Student App

- A dedicated **Important Documents** section, giving students quick access to key documents all in one place.





Feature focus: Parent App (MyChildAtSchool)

We are enhancing the **Parental Consents** page in the **Parent App** to give contacts a clear overview of all consents, their current status, and the ability to respond directly within the app.


Parental consents will be **configurable**, allowing schools to manage and customise the Parental Consents page directly within the **MIS**.



Feature focus: Seating Plan and Behaviour

Further enhancements to Seating Plan

- A refreshed **Room Layouts** interface, using the new Seating Plan with a modern drag-and-drop furniture panel. Old UI will be replaced by new UI in teacher dashboard.
- **Student tiles** will display key information at a glance, including behaviour and birthday indicators, and user-defined flags.
- **Faster behaviour recording**, allowing teachers to log events in just two clicks with configurable event priorities.




Feature focus: School Finance

You'll be able to set up **basic and advanced approval workflows** based on values, cost centres, and roles, with easier options to select and apply rules across all relevant areas.





Feature focus: Vision Analysis
